



Daycare Guidelines

Please read and initial the following

___ All dog's must pass our meet and greet screening process before attending. This gives us a chance to ensure that all dogs that come to play or stay with us are a good fit for this type of environment. The screening process will take approximately 1 – 2 hours. During the process, we will slowly introduce your dog to our daycare group and our daycare routine. If your dog responds well to our daycare environment, they are welcome to join our pack. If your dog does not respond well, you will be given a list of recommended training your dog could do before they can try the screening process again. The screening process can be done Monday – Friday between 11:00 am and 5:00 pm. If your dog passes the screening process, they may spend the remainder of the day with us.

___ For you and your dog's safety you aren't allowed to enter the transition or daycare area under any circumstances. We will strictly enforce this rule.

___ All dogs need to be ___ of age to attend our facilities and must have proper vaccinations.

___ All dogs must be spayed or neutered by breed recommendations, and no later than 12 months old.

___ All dogs must be current on vaccinations as well as current fecal. We require proof of vaccines or Blood Titers from your veterinarian.

___ If fleas are found on your dog while in our care, they will receive a Capstar or flea bath. You will be responsible for any charges. There is a higher risk of your pet getting fleas when socializing with other dogs. It is highly recommended that you treat your dog with a monthly topical or oral flea preventative.

___ Only designated contacts approved by you may pick your dog. We will not release your dog to anyone not on your approved list. Identification will be required upon pick-up.

___ To prevent potential conflict, we ask that you not bring any personal items for your dog during their daycare stay.

___ We are not responsible for any damages that may occur to personal items. Although our employees will always properly care for these items; accidents can happen.

___ We will administer any provided food and/or medications during the daycare stay. Food and/or medication slip must be filled out and signed at drop-off.

___ Daycare pick up time is by 7:00 pm Monday – Friday and by 6:30 pm Saturday and Sunday. If you do not arrive by these times, you will be charged an overnight fee. We understand things happen and we are all late at one point or another, but all our staff have families and busy schedules of their own.

___ Any dog left at All Access Doggy Daycare for 1 week or more past their scheduled pick-up date without contact and/or arrangements will be considered abandoned, at which point we will proceed according to the guidelines provided by the Revised Code of Washington 16.54 RCW. Client will still be held liable for the cost of their dog's care.
